Position Summary:

The Equipment Manager is responsible for overseeing all team equipment needs, ensuring players are properly outfitted, maintaining gear and locker room organization, and supporting overall team operations on and off the ice. This role is critical in creating a professional, safe, and efficient environment for players and staff.

Key Responsibilities:

- Manage, maintain, and repair all hockey equipment including skates, helmets, gloves, pads, sticks, and jerseys.
- Sharpen and profile skates consistently and to individual player preferences.
- Set up and organize the locker room and team bench area for practices, games, and road trips.
- Prepare and transport team equipment for away games and tournaments, including packing and unloading.
- Maintain an accurate inventory of all team equipment, apparel, and supplies; track orders and re-orders as needed.
- Issue, collect, and clean equipment and uniforms throughout the season.
- Assist with laundry duties for jerseys, socks, towels, and other team apparel.
- Coordinate with vendors for purchasing, repairing, and customizing equipment.
- Work closely with coaching staff to ensure players' equipment needs and preferences are met.
- Support team operations as needed on game days
- Be in the office daily, time depending upon practices
- Help with practices a minimum of two days per week
- Must go on road trips
